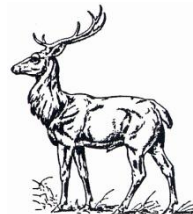

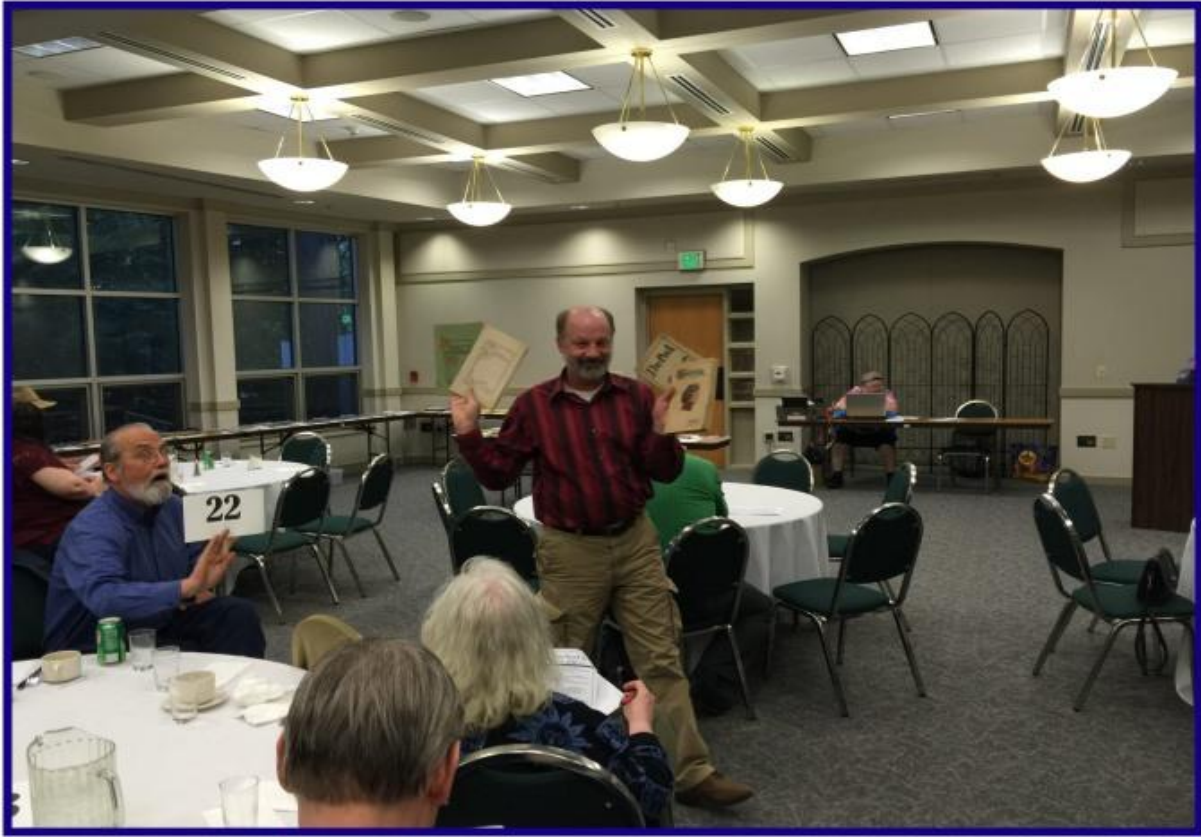
# Remembering the Antique Paper Round-Up

From the dust of my bosom!

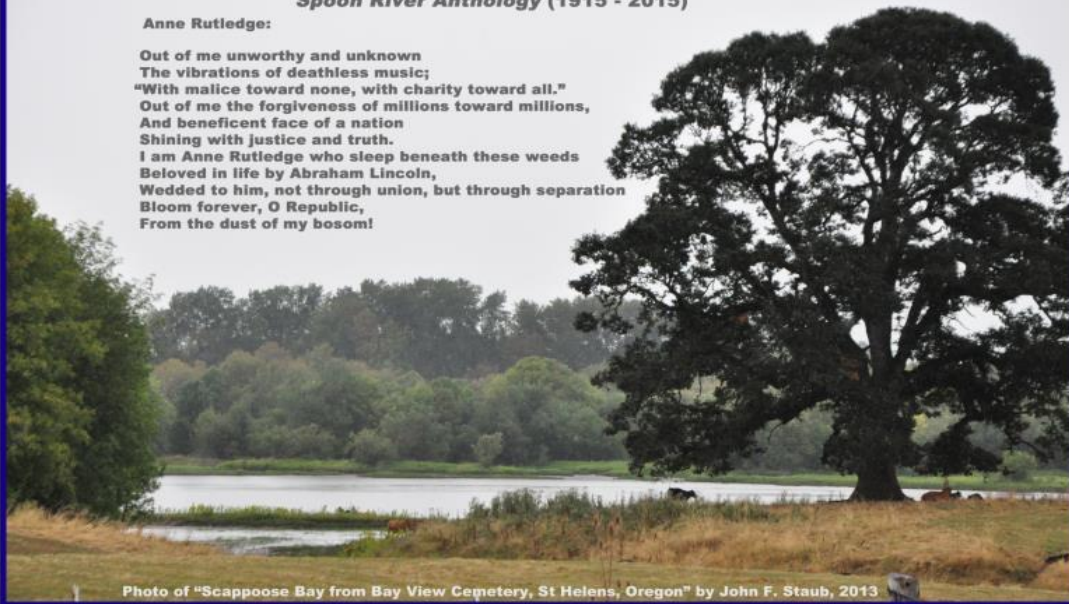
