CELEBRATE NATIONAL POSTCARD WEEK MAY 6 - 12, 2012 MAKING GOAT CHEESE

1 gallon goat's milk

- 1/4 cup white vinegar or lemon juice
- 1 tablespoon kosher salt
- Add any herb flavor you like.

Pictured: Pepper, Plain, Rosemary, Chives

Line a colander with cheesecloth. Heat milk in large pot, stirring constantly to 185 degrees F. Remove from heat. Slowly add vinegar of lemon juice, stir rapidly.



Pour the courds (the lumps) and whey (the liquid) onto the cheese cloth. Let drain. Squeeze as much moisture out as possible.Put in a large bowl. Stir in salt. Add your choice of seasonings for flavor.

Cover with plastic wrap. Refrigerate for 2 days before tasting. This makes a soft cheese that can be carefully sliced. Demaris Elrod Swint PO Box 746 Alamo, TX 78516 USA
